On Saturday November 14th, 2009, the Japan Gaelic and Athletic Association (GAA) will be hosting a charity ball to raise money and awareness for the registered charity Future Hope.

Future Hope is an orphanage and school for homeless and destitute children in Calcutta. Drawn from slums, the streets, red light districts, hospital and prisons, Future Hope currently houses 230 children ranging from 4 to 20 years of age – many of whom are seriously injured, ill, have alcohol and drug dependencies and have been subject to physical abuse. Beyond providing disadvantaged kids with a safe home, security and much needed love, Future Hope runs a school with over 150 pupils studying from Kindergarten to Class ten.

Sport also plays a major role at Future Hope in the development of discipline and a sense of purpose in many of the children. While many have played at the highest level (winning national honours representing India in Rugby), many children still have to train in their bare feet or flip flops and on game days the boots have to be shared out between teams.

The Japan GAA Bootie Ball 2009 has been organised to raise money to buy sports boots for these children and to support the next major project – the Future Hope Sports Academy.
